

OHEL LEAH SYNAGOGUE.

I have just received the attached letter from the Secretary of the Jewish Recreation Club, asking whether Jewish Members of H.M. Forces, University Students and Apprentices may become Associate non-voting Members of the Club for a monthly subscription of \$2, \$1 of which will be paid to the Synagogue.

The permission of the Trustees and Committee is required, since such an arrangement would entail our allowing the people referred to above to become Members of the Synagogue for \$1 per month instead of the present minimum subscription of \$3 per month.

I am in favour of granting this request, provided the people in question first send in their application for membership of the Synagogue, and in that application mention that they wish to take advantage of the special subscription fee allowed them on account of their being Jewish Members of H.M. Forces, or University Students, or Apprentices not earning their livelihood.

The views of my colleagues will be appreciated.
