

# FOOD KITCHENS

## URGENT APPEAL.

---

The Refugee and Social Welfare Council have up to now been indebted to the British Fund for the Relief of Distress in China for kindly financing the Food Kitchens.

A letter has now been received from the Committee of that Fund intimating that after June next, owing to the many claims on the Fund, they will be unable to continue their support.

There are 4 Food Kitchens, and between 4,000 and 5,000 destitute people receive once a day a bowl of rice and vegetables etc.—and the babies are supplied with milk.

It is probable that this is the only food these people get during the 24 hours.

The Food Kitchens *must* be kept going. We cannot let these people starve.

We are making an urgent appeal for contributions.

We need \$15,000 to carry us on to the end of the year, when other arrangements will be made for financing the Food Kitchens.
