AGENDA OF MATTERS TO BE DISCUSSED WITH BRIGADIER MACDOUGALL.China Light & Power Co., Ltd.

1. Is the China Light & Power Co. under Military control or under the control of its Board of Directors?
2. Is the China Light & Power Co. in charge of and responsible for the operation and maintenance of the electricity supply system in Kowloon, or is this the entire responsibility of the Military Authorities?
3. Who is responsible for reading meters and collecting accounts? The Military Authorities or the Company?
4. Who fixes rates and into whose account will money that is collected be paid?
5. Who pays the China Light & Power Co.'s staff?
6. Who pays the R.A.F. personnel at present working on the China Light & Power Co.'s system?
7. What is the financial situation of the China Light & Power Company vis-a-vis the Military Authorities?
8. Who is to give orders for urgent repairs to buildings, cable ducts, sea walls, etc? Can the Company employ its own contractors to do this work and if so how are the necessary materials to be obtained?
9. Will Government accept the report of responsible members of the Company's staff as sufficient evidence as to the condition of plant and buildings, etc?
10. Can repair work be put in hand immediately without prejudice to future claims?
