Dear Mr. Kadoorie,

I have to thank you for your letter S.3-A-4/ of 22nd inst. and for passing on the information concerning the need for a St. John ambulance at Un Long.

There used to be an ambulance at Un Long operated by St. John's. This was provided and maintained by Un Long people, but unfortunately it became worn out and could no longer be used.

Mr. David Wai Man Wei, who is in charge of St. John's New Territories Ambulance Divisions, has so far raised about \$15,000 towards the cost of a new ambulance for Un Long. He hopes that it will not be long before the rest of the money required is forthcoming and that St. John's ambulance service in Un Long is resumed.

Dr. Y. T. Wang, incidentally, is Divisional Surgeon of the Brigade's Un Long Ambulance Division. I have passed on to Mr. David Wai Man Wei the information Dr. Wang gave to you.

Thank you very much for your kind greetings, which my wife and I heartily reciprocate to you and Mrs. Kadoorie and your family.
