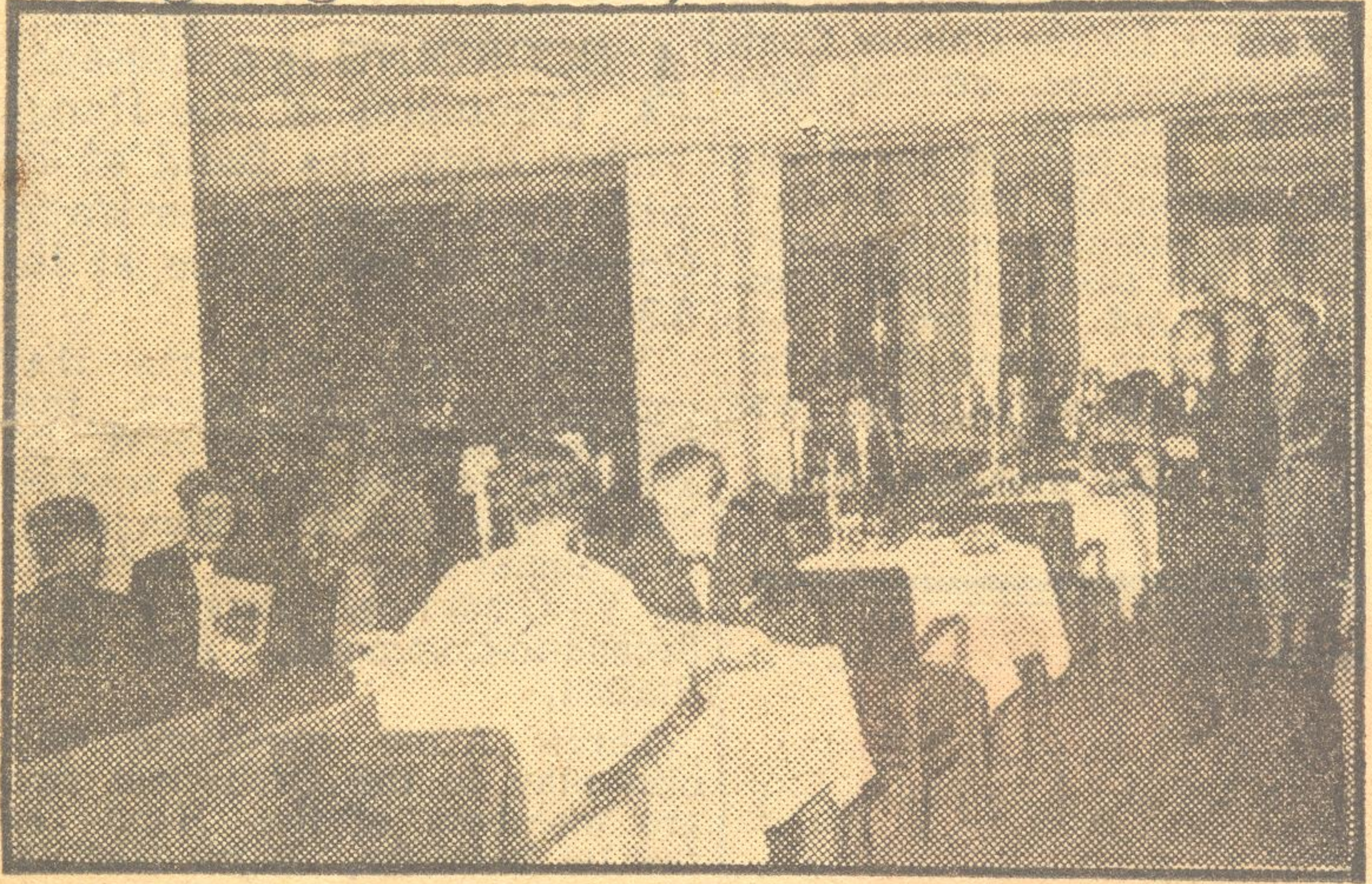


# Gaddi's Restaurant Opens
