Nelly Fung grew up in the Philippines. Her father was involved in the Philippine independence movement and later became ambassador in the Philippines' Foreign Services. Nelly Fung moved to Hong Kong with her husband in the 1960s and became involved in the development of Hong Kong's art scene. Fung also helped set up the Chinese International School.
