



## **HAYES, Lucy**

Lucy Hayes was born in Henley-on-Thames, United Kingdom and later trained to be a nurse. She married her husband, an Army Officer with the 2nd Battalion of the 7th Gurkha Rifles, and moved to Hong Kong together in 1981. Hayes later became Sir Horace Kadoorie's personal nurse and spent most of her time in Boulder Lodge and the Kadoorie Farm. Hayes has since moved back to the U.K..
