Tim Huxley was born in Newcastle-upon-Tyne, United Kingdom and received his Arts degree from the University of Edinburgh. Huxley joined Clarksons, a shipping company in 1982 and went on to work there for 24 years. At the time of the interview Tim Huxley was the Chief Executive of Wah Kwong Shipping.
