



JOHNSTON, Veronica

Veronica Johnston was born in the United Kingdom in 1936 and was evacuated to the United States along with her family in 1940. Johnston's grandparents were Helena and Henry May, who was the Governor of Hong Kong from 1912-1919. Johnston herself worked as an occupational therapist and had travelled extensively across Rhodesia (Zimbabwe) in the 1960s.
