



## **KADOORIE, Sir Michael**

Born in Hong Kong just before the Japanese occupation in 1941, Sir Michael Kadoorie is the son of the late Lord Kadoorie and Lady Muriel. At the time of the interview, he was Chairman of the Hongkong and Shanghai Hotels, Limited, the CLP Holdings Limited, Heliservices (HK) Limited, and Metrojet Limited. Sir Michael also holds a number of other directorships and acts as trustee on a number of charitable institutions.
