Mary Killeen was born in Fuzhou, China and grew up in Shanghai. Killeen was interned by the Japanese at Cha Pei Camp and later moved to Hong Kong in 1951. She subsequently worked at the Bursar's Office at the University of Hong Kong and Jardines. Killeen immigrated to Canada in 1980.
