Sir Rogeiro Hyndman Lobo was a Hong Kong businessman, philanthropist and politician of Portuguese and Scottish descent. He was a former member of the Urban Council, Executive Council and Legislative Council. Sir Roger is best known for his Lobo Motion during the negotiation between the United Kingdom and China in the 1980s.
