



## **NIELD, Robert**

Robert Nield was born in Manchester in 1952 and spent his early years travelling the globe as his father was attached to the British Army at various posts. Nield qualified as a chartered accountant and came to Hong Kong in 1980 to work for PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC). Nield was also the author of *Counting House*, a book on the history of PwC. At the time of the interview, he was President of the Royal Asiatic Society.
