



## **SALISBURY-JONES, Raymond**

Raymond Salisbury-Jones was born in the United Kingdom in 1933 and lived in different regions in Africa since his father was posted there as a Commander of the Coldstream Guards. Salisbury-Jones joined Rolls-Royce in the 1950s, following his family's engineering and Rolls-Royce lineage. He worked as Rolls-Royce's Export Manager and sold The Peninsula its first fleet of Rolls-Royce cars.
